Why do private backyard lessons?

- 1. Convenient no driving, no traffic, just relax by your pool while your children learn to swim
- 2. Safety Your children learn how to be safe around your pool
- 3. Have family or friends join the lesson. We charge by time. We recommend no more than 3 at a time. If you have 6, just split them up and add more time.
- 4. We can cater the lesson to your individual needs, just let your instructor know what you are interested in.
- 5. Add a class randomly, why not? We are flexible.

All of our instructors have the following certifications:

- Swim Instructor
- National Lifeguards
- Standard First Aid and CPR-C.

They have also received Davina's Swim House Instructor training.



At Davina's, a safe and quality swim lesson is paramount not only for your children but our instructors as well. A few things we want to ensure so that everyone can get the maximum enjoyment and be safe at all times:

- Provide a safe, clean pool.
- The bottom of the deep end must be visible at all times.
- The chemistry of the water should be within the optimal ranges (see back page)
- Pool temperature at 85 degrees min
- Have a working phone nearby
- If more than 1 child is in a lesson who is a non-swimmer, an adult must be present.

Please note that Davina's Swim House reserves the right to cancel a lesson without rescheduling should the pool not meet the above requirements

Other tips:

Please ensure all swimmers are prepared for their lesson prior to the instructor's arrival so we can begin our lesson at your designated time.

Ensure your instructor has your correct contact information so they can keep you updated on any changes due to inclement weather or time alterations.



The health and safety of our valued swim families and staff is our number one priority.

- Whenever possible, Instructors will enter through an outdoor entrance to access the pool.
- Pool chemistry may be checked by the instructor upon arrival Should the pool chemistry be out of range, the lesson will be cancelled.

Inclement Weather

In the event of inclement weather, our instructors will reach out to you to cancel lessons. Only in the event of a thunderstorm or heavy rain where the bottom of the pool cannot be clearly seen, lessons will be cancelled and rescheduled. Lessons will still run through rainy and cloudy days.

Make-up Classes


Backyard lessons will only qualify for makeup classes in the event of inclement weather. Classes cancelled due to vacations, unbalanced or dirty pools, or other reasons will not qualify for makeup lessons as the instructors' schedules are quite full and they will not have the flexibility to reschedule. Should you need to cancel a lesson, please contact your instructor, a minimum of 24 hours prior to the lesson to inform them of the cancellation. Pool Chemistry and Cleanliness

Pool chemistry and cleanliness are requirements for our instructors to teach at your pool. A well-balanced and maintained pool ensures that no bacteria, pathogens, viruses or germs are able to grow or live in the water. Your pool water also must be clear and not green due to algae. It should be skimmed and kept clean of all possible plants, insects and animals. Our instructors must be able to see the bottom of the deep end.

Our instructors reserve the right to check the chemicals when they visit your pool and have the right to cancel a lesson with no makeup provided should the pool chemicals be unbalanced or the water is unclean. In order for our instructors to safely instruct in your pool, we require you to maintain the following chemical levels:
